संक्षिप्त परिचय:

अफगान को अर्थ Avagan (Uzbeck word) मा Original अथवा मूलवासी आदिवासी भन्न खोजिएको देखिन्छ। त्यस्तै गरी अफगानिस्तान को अर्थ **Land of the Afghans** भन्ने रहेछ ।**तालिवान** को अर्थ पश्तुन भाषामा विद्धार्थी रहेछ। अफगानस्तान हाल [Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan] मध्य तथा दक्षिन ऎशिया मा फैलिएको एक भूपरिवेष्ठित स्वन्त्र राष्ट्र हो। यसको पुर्व र दक्षिन मा पाकिस्तान, पश्चिम मा इरान , उत्तर मा तुर्कमेनिस्तान र उज्वेकिस्तान र उत्तर पूर्व मा ताजिकस्तान र चीन संग सीमाना जोडिएका छन। करिव **६५२८६४** वर्ग किलो मिटर क्षेत्रफल रहेको यो देश ठुल्ठुला पहाड पर्वत देखि समथर जिमन सम्ममा फैलिएको छ, जहा अमूल्य खनिज पदार्थको भण्डार नै रहेको अनुसन्धान र अनुमान ले देखाउंछ ।राष्ट्र भाषा पश्तो र दारी हन भने कुल जनसंख्याको करिव ९९ प्रतिशत मुस्लिम र वांकी १ प्रतिशत अन्य धर्मावलम्बी रहेको यो देश को जनसंख्या करिव ४) करोड रहेको अनुमान छ । तालिवान समूह ले **१५ अगस्त २०२१** मा काबुल प्रवेश र नियन्त्रण पछि तत्कालै देश को नाम र राष्ट्रिय झण्डा परिवर्तन गरी सके का छन । संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका र सम्वद्द राष्ट्र हरुको सैनिक संगठन नेटोका सेनाहरु सम्झौता मा उल्लेख मिति भन्दा १ दिन अगावै **३० अगस्त २०२१** मा फिर्ता भए पछि तालिवान समूह ले हाल **७ सेप्टेम्बर २०२१** मा इरानी मोडल को अन्तरिम सरकार को घोषणा गर्यो, जसमा देशको सर्बोच्च नेता मा Mawlawi Hibatullah Akhundzada लाई तोक्यो भने प्रधानमन्त्री मा मुल्लाह महमद हसन अखुन्द लाई तोकी निजको अदक्षता मा मन्त्रिपरिषद को गठन गरिएको छ। सामान्यतय जव कुनै राष्ट्र मा बिद्रोही वा Coup समूह द्वारा राष्ट्र को सत्ता र शक्ति कब्जा गरिञ्छ र वैधानिक सरकार पतन हुञ्छ भने त्यस वखत त्यस्ता देश को प्रचलित संविधान र कानुनहरु चूप हन पृग्दछन। सत्ता र शक्ति कब्जा गरेका त्यस्ता समूह को आदेश नै कानुन सरह मान्न नागरिक वाध्य हुन्छन। शासन संचालन मा प्रचलित संविधान र कानुन को प्रयोग छैन, निर्वाचन को मध्यम बाट नया विधायिका गठन र त्यस्ता विधायिका वाट कानून को निर्माण भै त्यस्ता कानून को , प्रायोग र पालना पनि भएको छैन र त्यस्तो सरकार लाई अन्तराष्ट्रिय समुदाय ले पनि मान्यता दिइसकेको छैन भने त्यस्तो अवस्थालाई de-facto नियन्त्रण र संचालन मानिञ्छ। यथार्थ मा सत्ता र शक्ति कब्जा र संचालन भएको हुञ्छ, तर वैधानिकता हुदैन।अफगानिस्तान को हाल को तालिवानी सरकार पनि यही अवस्था को सरकार हो।संयुक्त राष्ट्र संघ को हाल [**सन् २०२१**] संचालन भैरहेको **७६** औं साधारण सभा सम्पन्न भैसके पछी विश्व समुदाय को धारणा सहित पछि तालिवान सत्ता ले लिने उदार वा अनुदार नीति, महिला, बाल अधिकार, मानवाधिकार नीति हरु को समग्र मुल्यांकन गर्दै केही इस्लामिक राष्ट्र हरु वाट मान्यता शुरु हुदै अन्य राष्ट्रहरु, अन्तराष्ट्रिय समुदायहरु, संगठन हरु बढ्दै जालान । वर्तमान तालिवानी सरकारले संशोधन नगर्दा सम्म हाल सम्म यो देश को केन्द्रीय राजधानी **काबुल** हो । देश लाई **३४** प्रान्त मा विभाजन गरिएको छ र प्रत्यक प्रान्त मा गभर्नर रहने व्यवस्था छ। देश को मुद्रा Afghan Aghani (AFN) हो । प्रमुख शहर हरु मा काबुल , कांधार, मजार -ए - शरिफ, हेरात र जलालावाद आदि छन्। हाल निष्क्रय मानिएको देश को पछिल्लो प्रजातान्त्रिक संविधान २००४ मा लागु भएको थियो। २५० सदस्य रहने तल्लो सदन ओलेसी जिर्गा र १०२ सदस्य रहने माथिल्लो सदन मेशारानो जिर्गा सहित को नेशनल एसेम्बली, [विधायिका] को प्रथम निर्वाचन **२००५** साल मा सम्पन्न भएको थियो। राष्ट्रपति १ र उप- राष्ट्रपति २) को व्यवस्था ,राष्ट्रपति राष्ट्र प्रमुख, सरकार प्रमुख एबम सेना का परमसेनाधिपति रहने र सेना मा अफगानिस्तान नेशनल आर्मी रहने व्यवस्था थियो। यो देश संयुक्त राष्ट्र संघ को सदस्य सन् १९४६ मा भएको छ भने संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका संग १९३५ मा र नेपाल संग १ जुलाई १९६१ मा दौत्य सम्बन्ध कायम भएको छ । प्राचीन एबं ऐतिहासिक रुपमा हेर्दा यो भूमि भारत वर्ष इन्द्रश र हिन्दकुश सभ्यता अन्तरगत अनेकन समुदायहरु खासगरी हिन्दु र बुद्ध धर्मावलम्वीहरू बहसंख्यक रहेको देखिञ्छ। हाल को कांधार लाई त्यस वखत गान्धार साम्राज्य भिनदो रहेछ। गन्ध +आर = गंधार .अर्थ खुश्व को साम्राज्य, जहा भगवान शिव जी को पुजा गरिन्थ्यो। आज भन्दा **५५००** वर्ष पहिला त्याहाका राजा सुवाला ले राज्य गर्दथे र आफ्नो राजकऱ्या को नाउ नै गान्धारी राखिदिए का थिए। पछि उनको को विवाह हस्तिनापुर नरेश धृतराष्ट्र संग भएको धार्मिक इतिहास छ । इतिहासका अनेक काल खण्डमा यहाँ अनेकन युद्ध छेडिएका छन् , Alexander the Great, मौर्य हरु, अरब मुस्लिम , मंगोलहरु, ब्रिटिश ,शोभियत संघ र पछिल्लो समय संयुक्त राज्यअमेरिका र सम्बद्ध राष्ट्रका सैनिक संगठन नेटो समेत को युद्ध मैदान बन्न पुग्यो। अफगान क्षत्रगत रुपमा **सन** १७०९ मा अस्तित्त्व मा आएको यो देश तत्कालिन त्यहाका लोकप्रिय राजा Ahamad Shah Durrani को शासनकाल सन् १७४७-१७७३ बाट आधुनिक राष्ट्र को रुपमा उत्पति भएको देखिन्छ। त्यसैगरी खासगरी तेस्रो एँलो अफगान युद्ध **१९१९** बाट विस्तार हुदै **सन् १९२६** मा राजा अमनुल्लाह को विजयी र नियन्त्रण पछि यहा राजनैतिक स्थिरता आएको र राजा हरु ले १९२६ देखि १९७३ सम्म त्यहा शासन गर्दा अफगानी जनताको जीवनस्तर, समाज को स्तर निक्कै माथि उठेको, देखिन्छ । त्यस वखत महिला र बालिका हरु को जीवनस्तर अहिले का लन्डन र पेरिस का महिला र बालिका को भन्दा कम नभएको भन्ने गरिन्छ। Cold War को समयमा समाजवादी शासन रहेको तत्कालिन शोभियत् रुसले अफगानिस्तान को आन्तरिक राजनीति मा हस्तक्षेप गर्दै उसै को अगुवाई मा अफगानिस्तान का राजा मोहम्मद जाहिर शाह लाइ आफ्नै आफन्त सैनिक र राजनैतिक कर्मी को षड्यन्त्र मा पारी वहा लाई सन **१९७३ जलाई १७** अपदस्त गरियो। **१५ अक्टोबर १९१४**

मा जन्मी १९ वर्षको उमेरमा **८ नोवेम्बेर १९३३** देखि राजा बनेका एक कुशल, भद्र शासक राजा को 39 वर्षे शासन काल समाप्त भै देश मा गणतन्त्र घोषणा भयो। **सन १९७८** को अप्रिल क्रान्ति दोस्रो Coup पछि जव देश मा समाजवादी सरकार बन्यो , तव देखि राजनीति मा कट्टर धार्मिक विचार धारा मा विश्वास गर्ने राजनैतिक समुहहरु , अतिवादी धार्मिक समुहहरु , सरिया कानुनमा आधारित इस्लामिक धार्मिक शुद्धिकरण को मुद्धाअघि सारेर खडा भएको विद्ध्यार्थी संगठन तालिवान समूह समेत बिद्रोही मुजाहिद्दीन समूह मा समाहित हुदै सन् १९८० मा शोभियत्- अफगान युद्ध मा होमिए भने सरकार पनि दमन मा उत्रियो। यो युद्द मा कैयौ अफगानी जनता मारिए भने कैयौ संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका, पाकिस्तान र भारत समेत मा शरणार्थी को रूप मा पलाएन भए। यही समय बाट यो देश को आधुनिक वर्वादी शरु भएको देखिञ्छ। एकातिर मानवीयता का अधार मा आफहरु ले यस्ता शरणार्थी लाई आफ्नो देश मा शरण दिई भरण पोषण र वसोवास को व्यवस्था मिलाउन पर्ने अर्को तर्फ़ शोभियत रुसले कम्युनिष्ट समाजवादी सरकार विस्तार गर्दै गएको हुँदा संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका लगाएत पश्चिम जगत लाइ मन परेन र पाकिस्तान संग मिलेर मुजाहिद्दीन समूहरु लाई सहयोग गर्दै गए। फल स्वरूप शोभियत् रुसका **सेना १५ फेब्रुवरी १९८९** देखि **१९९२** सम्म मा फिर्ता भए भने **अप्रिल १९९२** मा शोभियत् रुस समर्थित राष्ट्रपति डा नजिबुल्लाहले राजिनामा दिए सगै समाजवादी सरकार को पतन भयो र बिद्रोही मुजाहिद्दीन समुह को कब्जा नजिक मा पुग्यो सत्ता । राष्ट्रपति डा नजिबुल्लाह को राजिनामा पछि नेता बुरानुद्दीन रब्बानी को अदक्षता मा सरकार बन्यो रब्बानी र गुलबुद्दीन हिक्मतियार जस्ता नेता हरु, समुहहरु विच को शासन सत्ता किचलो राष्ट्रिय सहमति र स्थायित्व मा पुग्दा नपुग्दै**सन् १९९६** मा तालिवान ले नै सत्ता कब्जा गरे । यो परिस्थिको को आंकलन गर्दै पुर्व राष्ट्रपति नजिबुल्लाहले आफ्नो परिवार भारत पठाइसकेका थिए। केहि समय पछि आफु काबुल स्थित संयुक्त राष्ट्र संघ भवन मा शरण लिइरहेका थिए । संयुक्त राष्ट्र संघ नजिबुल्लाह लाई भारत मा शरण पाउने सुनिश्चिता गर्न भारत सरकार संग अनुरोध गर्यो। समय समयमा इस्लामी धार्मिक संगठन हरु वाट अप्ठ्यारो मा परिरहे को अवास्था मा तालेवानी सरकार को भावना मा ठेस नपुग्ने गरि शरण दिन चाहान्थ्यो भारत तर तालिवान ले नजिबुल्लाह लाई छोड्न चाहेनन्। अन्तत:तालिवान ले २७ सितम्बर १९९६ मा डा नजिबुल्लाह लाई सार्वजनिक स्थानमा बर्बर तरिकाले लडकाएर फाँसी दिई केहि दिन लडकाइ रहे। तालिवान समृहले शासन सत्ता वागडोर लिइ सकेर पनि धार्मिक कट्टरता बाट वाहिर आउन चाहेनन्। महिला हरु घर मा नै सिमित हुन बाध्य भए। आधुनिक शिक्षा ,आधुनिक समाज निर्माण मा पूर्ण विराम लाग्यो। त्यसैले केहि सिमित इस्लामिक राष्ट्र बाहेक अन्तराष्ट्रिय समुदाय ले मान्यता दिइसकेका थिएनन। **मार्च 2001** तालेवान ले बुद्ध को मुर्ति तोडफोड गरे। संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका भारत लगाएत धरै देश हरु ले यो कार्य को भर्त्सना गरे। नेपालले पनि दुख व्यक्त गर्यो। यो घटना वाट अन्तराष्ट्रिय समुदायहरु शसंकित भैसकेको थिए। अफगानी लोकप्रिय नेता हमिद कारजाई तालेवान तथा अन्य समुहहरु, र पश्चिमी जगत, इटाली मा निर्वासमा रहेका पूर्व राजा संग संवादको प्रयास गर्दैगर्दा का वखत वहा का बाबु पुर्व राजनीतिज्ञ अब्दुल अहमद कारजाई लाई शरण मा रहेका बखत पाकिस्तानको कोयटा शहर मा मस्जित बाट घर फर्किदै गर्दा तालिवान ले हत्या गरेका थिए। त्यो घटना पछि हमिद कारजाई ले तालेवान संग सम्बन्ध टुटाई पंजशिर घाटी का जाने माने नेता अहमद शाह मसुद सग सम्बन्ध विस्तार गरेर तालेवान को आतंकी अत्याचार बिरुद्द आवाज उठाउदै रहे। त्यस्तै गरी कारजाई र अहमद शाह मसुदले तालिवान अलकायदा संग जोडिएका छन संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका मा समेत मा हमला हन सक्छ भनि सचेत र सुचित गराएका रहेछन। **९ सेप्टेम्बेर** २००१ मा अलकायदा को एजेन्ट को आत्मा घाती बम हमला मा नेता मसुद मारिए। ठीक दुइ दिन पछि **११ सेप्टेम्बेर २००१** मा आतंकवादी संगठन अलकायदा ले संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका को न्युयोर्क शहरको विशाल व्यापारिक जुल्याह भवन हरु समेतमा हमला गर्यो ,जसका कारण ठुलो धन-जन क्षति हुन पुग्यो। **२९७७** भन्दा बढी निर्दोष अमेरिकी नागरिक मारिए भने **६०००** भन्दा बढी घाइते भए। यो दुखद घटना को मुख्य योजनाकार ओसमाविन लादेन भएको र उनि अफगानिस्तान मा रहेको पुष्टि भए पछि निजलाई पक्राउ गरी संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका लाई सुपुर्दगी गर्न संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका ले तालिवानी शासक लाई आग्रह गर्यो तर तालिवान ले ओसमाविन लादेन लाई सुपुर्दगी गर्न राजि भएनन ।त्यसैले संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका र सम्बद्ध राष्ट्रहरु को सैनिक संगठन नेटो का सेना हरु द्वारा काबुल लगाएतका तालिवानी ठेगानामा हवाई हमला समेत शुरु गर्दै गए। फलस्वरूप **६ दिसम्बर २००१** मा तालिवान काबुल वाट भागे। दशकौ को सैन्य वल प्रयोग पछि उनीहरु अफगानस्तान र पाकिस्तान का दुर्गम गाउ मा सिमित भए। इस्लामिक लडाकू हरुको विशेष सुरक्षा घेरा मा अफगानस्तान को दुर दराज र पाकिस्तानी क्षत्रमा ओहोर दोहोर गर्दै अलकायदा संगठन चलाई रहेका ओसामा विनलादेन संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका को विशेष सैन्य दस्ता द्वारा पक्राउ गर्ने प्रयास गरे। लादेन महिलालाई मानव ढाल बनाउदै भाग्न खोजे तर सफल भएनन् अन्तत: **२ मे २०११** मा पाकिस्तानको Abbottabad मा मारिए। ओसामा को अन्त्य पछि आतंकवादी संगठन अलकायदा कमजोर भएको ठानियो र **२०१२** देखि अफगानस्तान मा विदेशी सैनिकको उपस्थिति घटाउन थालियो भने Dec 28, 2014 मा नेटो ले अफगानस्तानमा आतंकवाद विरुद्ध संचालित १३ वर्षे युद्द समाप्ति को घोषणा गर्यो। तर अफगान नेशनल आर्मीलाई प्रशिक्षन तालिम र हात हतियार व्यवस्थापन र मानवीय सेवा का लागि केहि सिमित विदेशी सेना रहने व्यवस्था गरियो। २००१ देखि २०२१ का विच मा अफगानस्तानमा २००४-२००९ सम्म र २००९- २०१४ सम्म दुइ पटक र अन्तरिम काल सहित तेस्रो कार्यकाल सम्म नेता हमिद कारजाई राष्ट्रपति बने भने २०१४-२०२० र २०२० अर्को कार्य कालमा १**५ अगस्त २०२१** मा विदेश पलायन नहदा सम्मका लागि नेता अशरफ घानी राष्ट्र पति बने दुवै योग्य हुदाहुदै पनि तालेवान समूह लाई नियन्त्रण, सहमति ल्याई सबैको सहभागिता मा सहमति को सरकार गठन गरी सुशासन सहित जातिय कविला लडाई को अन्य गर्दै अफगान राष्ट्रवादी समाज को निर्माण गर्न, सेना तथा सुरक्षा निकायको मनोवल उच्च राख्न असफल नै रहे।

झट्ट हेर्दा अनौठो त के देखिञ्छ भने ९९ प्रतिशत मुस्लिम धर्मावलम्वी रहेको यो देशमा प्राचिन Original Homogeneous Society देखिदैन। विगतमा जो जसले यहा आक्रमण गरे उनीहरु आ -आफ्ना समुदाय हरु बसाउदै गए। त्यस्ता समुदायहरु बीच कबिला लडाई चिलरह्यो। प्राचिन हिन्दु र बौद्ध समुदायको पलाएन र राजाहरु को शासन समाप्त भए पछि त्यहा का हरेक अशिक्षित वयस्क पुरुष मदरसामा सामान्य शिक्षा लिने दुश्मन बिरुद्द बन्धुक उठाउने मार्ने या अल्लाह का लागि मर्ने भन्ने मान्यता देखिञ्छ।अफगानिस्तान का दुर गाउ वा शहर हरेक भित्ता र रुख हरुमा पनि गोलि का चिन्हहरु देखिञ्छन। पुर्व राष्ट्रपति नजिबुल्लाह लगाएत केहि विद्रोही नेता हरु लाई Butcher of Kabul or Butcher of Afghanistan को संज्ञा दिने गरिन्छ। तेसै ले अफगानिस्तान लाई Graveyard of the Empire पनि भनिदो रहे छ।। २००१ देखि २०२१ सम्म अफगान युद्ध खर्च को हिसाब हेर्दा

हाल सम्म को अनुमान 2 trillion USD भन्दा बढी अमेरिकी सरकार वाट खर्च भएको देखिञ्छ, भने दैनिक 300 Million USD व्ययभार हुने गरेको रहेछ । २४०० भन्दा बढी अमेरिकी सैनिक ले जीवन विलदान गर्नु पर्यो। अन्तराष्ट्रिय विवादमा मानब अधिकारको चरम उल्लघन छैन, आतंकबाद समाबेश छैन वा न्युन छ भने र बिश्व राजनीति भिन्न कठिन अवस्तामा बिश्वो समुदाय अलगै दुर्बिकरण हुन पर्ने अवस्तामा बाहेक एस प्रकारका क्षितिको न्यूनीकरण बाटो को खोजीमा अमेरिकी राजनीतिले पिन सोचिरहेकै अवस्था मा खास गरी सन् २०१६ को राष्ट्रपतीय चुनाव मा डोनाल्ड ट्रंप ले विजय हासिल गरी २० जनवरी २०१७ देखि कार्य काल शुरु गर्नु भए पिछ यी सबै अवस्थालाइ दृष्टिगत गरी धन -जन क्षिति को बाटो युद्ध भन्दा सुझ बुझ का साथ संवाद को बाटो उत्तम हुने राष्ट्रपति ट्रंप र ट्रंप सरकार को नीति बनेको र सो नीति बमोजिम तालेवान संग वार्ता का लागि अफगान -अमेरिकी नागरिक पूर्व कुटनीतिज्ञ जल्मेय खिललजाद लाई 5 सेप्टेम्बर २०१८ मा सरकार ले विशेष दुत नियुक्त गर्यो। राष्ट्रपति आफै पिन कोरियन युद्ध र विभाजन पिछ सबै सम्बन्ध बन्द भएको उत्तर कोरिया संग को सम्बन्ध सामान्य गर्न ३० जुन २०१९ मा जानु भै त्याहा का नेता किम जोङ्ग उन संग भेट वार्ता गर्नु भएको थियो। वर्तमान राष्ट्रपति ले पिन अफगान मामलामा राष्ट्रपति ट्रंप कै नीति लाई नै निरन्तरता दिनु भयो। अत विभिन्न चरण को वार्ता पिछ २९ फेब्रुवरी २०२० मा कतार को दोहा मा संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका र तालेवान वीच ऐतिहासिक सम्झौता भएको थियो। सो सम्झौता मा तालिवान को तर्फ बाट मुल्ला बरादर ले हस्ताक्षर गरेका थिए। त्यस पिछ तालेवान ले अमेरिकी सेना माथि आक्रमण गर्न बन्द गरे।

वर्तमान अफगान घटना क्रम र यसका असरहरु:

[१] संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका र तालिवान वीच भएको दोहा सम्झौताले सरकार र सेना र सुरक्षा निकायको मनोवल कमजोर भएको तर तालेवान को बढेको देखियो। विदेशी सेना फिर्ता हुन १६ दिन अगावै अप्रत्यासित तरिकाले १५ अगस्तमा नै विदेश मा शरण का लागि राष्ट्रपित घानि पलाएन भए र तालिवान आफैले सम्भव नठानेको अगस्त १५ मा नै विमानस्थल वाहेक काबुल समेत कब्जा गरे। यो घटनाले स्वयं तालिवान समूह, अन्तराष्ट्रिय समुदाय र अन्तराष्ट्रिय राजनीति नै अचम्वित र तरंगित बन्यो। यस सम्बन्ध मा दोहा सम्झौता का अमेरिकी प्रतिनिधि दुखि हुदै भनेका छन् सम्झौता मा तालिवान लडाकुहरु काबुल प्रवेश नगरी कान्धार मै सिमित रहने र केन्द्र मा तालिवान सहित सर्वपक्षिय सरकार बन्ने थियो, राष्ट्रपित को पलायनले वैधानिक सेना, सरकार पतन भयो र तालिवान ले सिधै कब्जा गरे अत: सम्झौता को मूल मर्म नै वाकी रहेन भने का छन्

- [**२] अगस्त १५ देखि ७ सेप्टेम्बर** सम्म अफगानिस्तान सरकार विहिन, राज्य विहिन ,अवस्था मा रहन पुग्यो।
- [३] तालिवानी धार्मिक कट्टरता विचार का कारण महिला हरु घरमानै बस्न वाध्य हुने छन्। निर्धन तथा एकल महिला का लागि अत्यन्तै कठिन दिन हुने छ। महिला तथा वालवालिका को स्वतन्त्रता लगायत मानब अधिकारको guarantee एवं दोहा सम्झौताको पालना नभए अन्तराष्ट्रिय समुदाय गम्भीर हुन बाध्य हुने अवस्था आउन सक्छ।
- [४] तालिवानी शासक हरुले कट्टर विचारधारा कम गरी देखिने गरी महिला तथा वाल हित मा काम नगर्दा सम्म अफगानिस्तान का अन्तराष्ट्रिय कोष हरु, सहायताहरु रोकिने हुदा गरिवी वाल कुपोषण र भोकमरी हुन सक्नेछ।
- [५] १५ अगष्ट मै अफगान सरकार को पतन र तालिबानको कबुलमा नियन्त्रणले गर्दा नेटो सेना फिर्ता हुदाका बखत त्यहाँ सैनिक बिमान, हेलिकोप्टर लगाएत अत्याधुनिक सैन्य हतियार समेत व्यबस्थापन नगरी छाड्नु परेको हुदा तेस्ता हतियार तालिवानले गलत प्रयोग र दमन गर्दछन कि भन्ने डर र अन्य आतंकारी संगठन हरुको पनि पहुच हुने हो कि भन्ने चिन्ता सर्वत्र छ।
- [६] यो घटना ले अफगान शरणार्थी को चाप संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिक, पाकिस्तान, भारत र इरान जस्ता देश लाई प्रतक्ष असर पर्ने छ। भारतीय संचार जगतका केही हिककत केहि बर्बराहट हेर्दा उ निकै सुरक्षा दवाव मा छ भन्ने प्रष्टै छ। तालिवानलाई रुपान्तरण गर्न भारत ले पिन अहम भूमिका निभाउनु पर्ने देखिञ्छ। पाकिस्तानका प्रधानमन्त्रि इमरानले अफगान सरकारले तालिबानलाई बार्तामा ल्याउन सकेन, अमेरिकाले नै पहल गरोस भन्ने चाहना थियो , तेसैले पाकिस्तानले तालिवानको जितलाई आफ्नै जित जस्तो ठानी जस लिन खोजेको ठिकै देखियो। तालिवान र अन्य धार्मिक संगठन हरु लाई कट्टरता बाट माथि उठाउन सके फलदाई हुने अन्यथा वर्तामान र भविष्यमा पिन सुरक्षा दवाव कम छैन। यसका बाछिटा नेपाल मा पिन पर्न सक्छन। केहि समूह खुशी भएको पिन देखियो। खुशी हुनु भन्दा सतर्क रहनु उत्तम हुने छ
